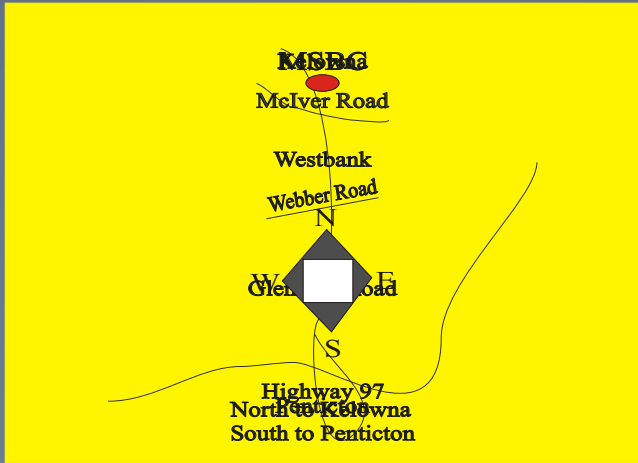

Preregistration is preferred for day camps and is also requested for all other camps.

- Register online at www.morningstarbiblecamp.com
- Remember to bring a friend who has never been to Morning Star Bible Camp before and use the discount coupon for both of you.
- **Day Camp** runs from Monday to Friday, from 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- **Boys, Girls, and Teen Camps** check in at 3:00 p.m. on the first day of camp. Check out and pick-up is at Morning Star Bible Camp at 10:00 a.m. on the last day of camp.
- **Young Men's Outdoor Camp** will leave MSBC at 1:00 p.m. on the first day and will return to MSBC at 12:00 noon on the last day. The camp will be held at a remote wilderness location and the campers will be transported to and from that location. Bring a good, warm, sleeping bag, rain gear, extra footwear, extra clothing, personal hygiene items, towel and flashlight. The fishing gear will be provided. **Featured activities: archery, camp fires, canoeing, fishing, fly tying, games, adventure trail hiking, paintball, riflery, wood carving, and more.**
- **Family Camp** check-in is at 3:00 p.m. on the first day of camp and check-out is at 10:00 a.m. on the last day of camp. Some individual rooms and cabins are available, so send your registration and reservations early. If you prefer, you could bring a tent, camper, or RV (non-serviced sites).
- **Adult Camp** check-in is at 3:00 p.m. on the first day of camp and check-out is at 10:00 a.m. on the last day of camp. Reserve your preferred accommodation early.
- Please fill out a separate registration form for each camper. For the Family Camps, only one form per family is required.
- Fill out the discount coupon and send along with your registration. Enclose a cheque made out to Morning Star Bible Camp for the full amount, and mail it to Morning Star Bible Camp, 3031 McIver Road West, Westbank, BC V4T 1C4.
